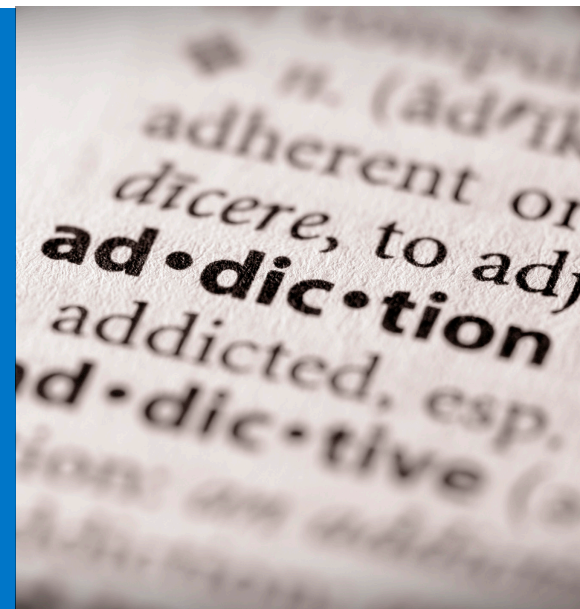

A JAAN Workshop for Jewish clergy and communal professionals

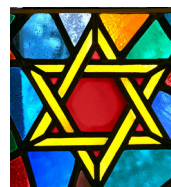
